Kalinga Institute of Industrial Technology (KIIT) Deemed to be University, Bhubaneswar, Odisha is a leading private multi-disciplinary University, known worldwide for its culture of educational excellence. Its cosmopolitan campus is proud to have more than 27,000 students from all corners of India and around 50 foreign countries, creating a mini metropolis in which a diverse multi-cultural community mingles and meets to study and interact. Student community of the University is highly disciplined due to its student-friendly policies.

2. KIIT University sprawls over 25 sq. km. area with one million square meters of aesthetically constructed built up area. There are 28 constituent Schools, contiguously located in impeccably landscaped and modern-technology-enabled campuses offering graduate, post-graduate, doctoral and post-doctoral programmes in various streams of Engineering, Bio-Technology, Business Management, Law, Languages, Medical Sciences, Dental Science & Nursing, Fashion Technology, Films, Sculpture, and Buddhism etc in a wide range of disciplines.

3. The University's solemn academic ambience has led to grant of A-Category status to it by the Ministry of HRD, Government of India, placing it among the most elite universities of the country. It is accredited by NAAC of UGC in 'A Grade'. Further, it has received Tier 1 (Washington Accord) accreditation by NBA of AICTE for engineering streams. Washington Accord accreditation enables global recognition of Degrees of the University.

4. KIIT is the youngest Deemed to be University in the country to figure in this prestigious ranking. In 2019, KIIT was placed at 31st rank in India by National Institution Ranking Framework (NIRF). All Engineering programmes have been accredited by the Institution of Engineering and Technology (IET), UK. Though very young, it is moving up the ladder of rankings and recognition with an increased acceleration with its focus on academics.

5. About 2500 academic and research staff and many leaders in their fields with international reputation provide a stimulating learning environment and excellent standard of teaching. Even though it is a self-financing institution, KIIT is a well-structured and decentralized organization. It is the only self-financing institution in the country where top functionaries, including Chancellor and Vice Chancellor are renowned academicians. The quality is amply demonstrated by the patents held by various faculty members, the research grants coming from various agencies both in India and abroad, national and international conferences, symposiums and workshops held here and 100% placement records.

Further, KIIT has an Industrial Training Institute (ITI), a Polytechnic, and an International School having affiliation with IGCSE-England, International Baccalaureate Programme (IBP), and CBSE India - the only one of its kind in the whole of Eastern India. The University has other recreational facilities and amenities like Sculpture Park, Art Gallery, Tribal Art Gallery, Rose Garden, Medicinal Herbs garden, etc. The hostels, food courts dotting the campus and other essential amenities like banking, postal services, transport, currency exchange counters, healthcare support, make the campus world class and worth studying and living.
